However, they may be deductible as ordinary and necessary business expenses subject to federal restrictions which prohibit the deduction of a portion of the dues used for certain lobbying activities. NCA estimates that the nondeductible portion of your dues for this year is 2.5%. This amount reflects only certain lobbying activities which are defined by federal law as nondeductible and does not reflect NCA's overall government relations effort.
